Who is eligible?



All students 4 years of age through to year 10 who have a Medicare Card



Students in years 11 and 12

who have a current Centrelink Card, Healthcare Card or Pension Card



o-3 year olds

whose parents have a current Centrelink Card, Healthcare Card or Pension Card



2-17 year olds

who are eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS). To check your eligibility visit the website at my.gov.au or phone 13 20 11.

Adults who hold a current Centrelink, Healthcare or Pension Card are also eligible for free public dental care.

Attending your child's appointment

Good dental health begins at home. That's why our children's dental program encourages all parents to be involved in their child's dental care. We ask that a parent or legal guardian attends every dental appointment with their child.

You can choose the clinic most convenient for you. All clinics have on-site client car parking.
