Inquiry Cycle of Edens Landing State School PBL Lesson	
1. Context:	Play areas
Orientate with a brief contextualisation for the benefit of the behaviour, linked to learning	Discuss with the class how to play all playground equipment safely. Bring the class down to the oval to demonstrate how to play each equipment in the PBL Green Bin. Senior Oval (green bin is placed at IPC Room) and Junior Oval (green bin is placed at B Block). Reminding the students about 'sharing' and being responsible when playing with the playground equipment.

2. Model and Explicitly Teach:	Students are to:

7. Correct:	A calmly delivered, concise physical and/or verbal assertion: - signals to a student that he/ she is behaving in a way that does not meet the expectations for learning - redirects the student to the activity with which they should be engaged
