# STAR PROGRAMS

In the Signature Academic Excellence STAR Program, students study their CORE subjects together, focusing on extending students' academic and enquiry skills. The English and Humanities component focuses on reading and writing excellence, while the Mathematics and Science component has a strong focus on higher order thinking skills and incorporates STEAM excellence (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts & Mathematics).

The Loganlea Institute of Sport STAR Program offers junior students a unique opportunity to participate in a specialised sporting program focused upon strength, fitness conditioning, training and game play skills. In this way the program establishes the basis for a lifetime of superior sports performance. Students can specialise in Upper 90, Netball or General sport.



The Loganlea Youth Development (Lifesaving) STAR Program develops students' leadership skills in the context of community service and Surf Life Saving. Students that successfully complete the program become fully qualified Surf Lifesavers.

The Dance STAR Program offers extensive training that promotes excellence through inter-school, eisteddfod and industry performances and workshops. Year 7, 8 & 9 students have the opportunity to participate in over 60 lessons per year through an elective dance subject and in the Star Dance program. Year 10, 11 & 12 students have the opportunity to participate in the Certificate II or III in Dance which is offered and run by trained industry professionals.



The Hospitality STAR Program will provide opportunities to work in our Trade Training Centre commercial kitchen and restaurant. Students will engage with industry partners and guest speakers and will explore the many facets of the Hospitality and Tourism sector. The program will assist students to become job ready and build confidence in their own ability to pursue a career in Hospitality. Senior students will complete certificates in Hospitality and Kitchen Operations.

The Agribusiness STAR Program will develop students' ability to lead and succeed in agribusiness through practical experience, curriculum, industry partnerships and independent projects. Students will work on the school's farm, go on excursions, attend guest presentations and represent Loganlea State High School at a range of events.
