Dear Parents/Caregivers

We are excited to offer your child/ren the opportunity to take part in the Water Safety Program.

Please note the following important information about the program

- This program will only take place if sufficient interest is indicated by the due date for payment. Payments will be refunded in full should the program not go ahead.
- Your child's attendance is dependent on their behaviour at school this term. Students considered high risk will not be permitted to attend the excursion, as we put the safety of our students above everything else.
- Only students who have paid in full by 10.30am on 16 November will be able to participate.
- You may arrange a payment plan with the school by speaking with the office prior to the cut-off date.
- Students attending need to ensure they have all the appropriate attire and equipment for lessons
- A medical certificate must be provided in order to claim a refund. A refund may or may not be granted. The cost of the bus is always non-refundable. If your child is excluded due to behavior issues no refund can be claimed.
- The following must be in place for students to be eligible to participate in camps, excursions and incursions:
 - o SRS Participation Agreement must have been returned to the school office
- O Scheduled payments for the SRS (i.e. Centrepay or installments) paid up-to-date, or paid in full No outstanding unpaid invoices
